I. Introductions and Celebrations:

II. Community Sharing:

Meal Sites- Information was shared for summer meal sites in the Gorge on the Oregon side. Discussion followed.

The Next Door Organization-Clay explained that Mentors for Success and Big Brother/Big Sisters are merging into Gorge Youth Mentoring on July 1, 2018.

Sheriff's Department-Sheriff Songer explained that their office will host tables at Goldendale Community Days and Klickitat county Fair. KLASAC will partner with their table at the fair if volunteers to host our own booth are a concern.

Klickitat Farmer's Market- Carl shared that Scott D., a new community member has been successful in setting up monthly farmer's market at the Depot Park the last Saturday of the month for July, August, and September.

Gorge Pride- Megan shared that there will be a guest speaker, activities, and 5k walk/run on June 30th in Hood River at the Waterfront Park in Hood River from 10:00-2:00 Pm. Megan also shared facts from the Washington Healthy Youth survey concerning how youth identify themselves.
