- Nine youth from Klickitat and Lyle attended Stand Up 4 Teens Conference in Stevenson on Monday.

- Youth had the opportunity to attend 7 different sessions throughout the day in a variety of topics such as vaping, human trafficking and looking at risk and protective factors.
